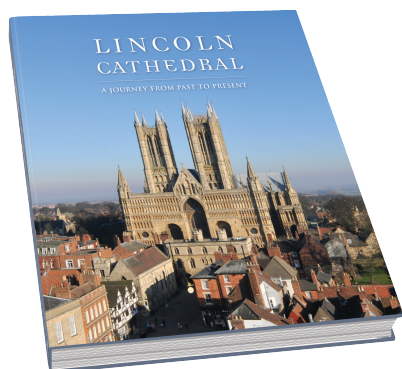


LINCOLN CATHEDRAL
